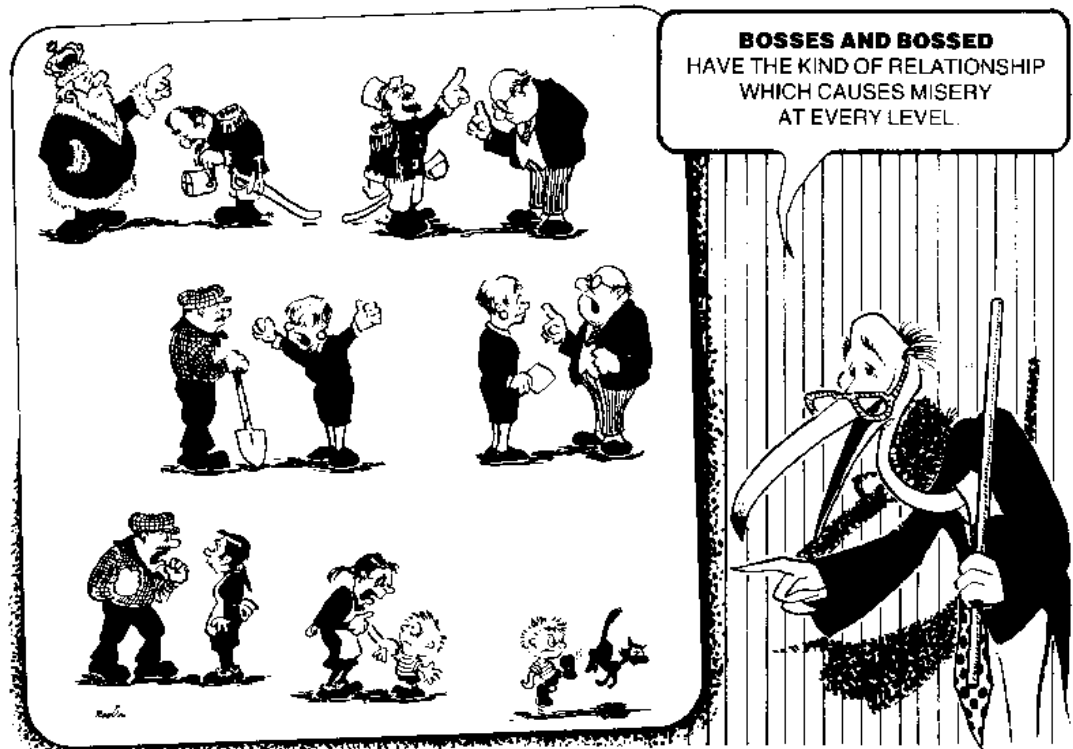
Despite recent major acts of civil disobedience against tyrannical capitalist organizations in Seattle and Washington DC, the left in North America is weak in two ways: there is no mass base of support and there is no vision. Protesters have too often proposed tearing down existing institutions with no plans for creating and building new institutions. More demonstrations are planned for August in Los Angeles at the Democratic National Convention. The August Collective is organizing a conference that will present a vision to complement the criticisms of the protests.

The North American Anarchist Conference: A Festival of Communities in Resistance will bring together radicals from all over the world to discuss the anarchist vision that we share.

As Anarchists we believe in the abolition of illegitimate authority. We believe in the promotion of solidarity, autonomy, diversity, and equality. We believe in the possibility of a society free from sexism, racism, capitalism, and the state.

Our conference will discuss this vision, strategy for reaching our goals, and tactics we use in our struggle. We will share knowledge and experience and create networks and plans for building a mass anarchist movement. We will also have events for the merely curious non-anarchist.

The first three days of the NAAC (August 11-13) will include speakers, workshops, films, study groups, networking, and plays. The last four days (August 14-17) coincide with the Democratic National Convention in Los Angeles. There will be direct actions and street protests taking place around the DNC. There will be no bands performing at the conference. No alcohol, drugs, or camera/video will be allowed at the conference.
